



EUROPEAN POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMME ON BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING

The Postgraduate Programme on Biomedical Engineering is organized by the **Faculty of Medicine** of the University of Patras, the Faculty of **Mechanical Engineering** and the Faculty of **Electrical and Computer Engineering** of the National Technical University of Athens, in collaboration with more than 20 European Universities.

1. Duration of studies:

The duration of studies for the Master of Science is four (4) academic semesters. The first and second semesters include mostly lectures, laboratories and exams. The following two semesters are mainly dedicated to the elaboration and the presentation of the Master's thesis. After having obtained their MSc, students who will have been selected may continue for a PhD.

2. Documents required for candidacy:

Candidates must submit to the Secretariat of the Medical School (ground floor) the following documents:

- An application form (also available at the Secretariat of the Medical School).
- A certified copy of their ID card.
- A certified copy of their diploma or degree, accompanied by a transcript of records.
- A short CV.
- Recommendation letters.
- A copy of a diploma proving the good knowledge of English.

Optional documents:

Copies of previous theses, participation in research projects, relevant work experience, etc.

Important Note:

Foreign students who wish to do postgraduate studies in Greece need to have their first diploma recognized by DOATAP. For more info, please visit <http://www.doatap.gr/en/index.php>.

3. Submission deadline:

For the academic year 2009-2010, students can apply until **Wednesday, September 9th 2009**. Applications will be evaluated following an interview that will be held on **Wednesday, September 16th 2009, at 11 a.m.**, in the Conference Room (ground floor) of the Computer Centre at the National Technical University of Athens (Zografou).

4. Selection of students:

The selection of postgraduate students is made according to the following criteria:

- a. Good knowledge of English, certified by an official diploma or a special examination.
- b. Evaluation of the candidates by an interview with the Selection Committee.
- c. Grade obtained for the diploma or degree (affinity between the diploma or degree and the specialization of the Postgraduate Programme will also be examined).
- d. Grades obtained in topics relevant to those of the Postgraduate Programme.
- e. Grade obtained for the diploma thesis.
- f. Research activity and publications (if any).

5. Total number of students:

The maximum number of students admitted to the Programme is thirty (30).
